The Beginning:

- 1938 Community members appeal to the city council of Redwood City and vote for a hospital to serve southern San Mateo County
- •1949- Construction of Sequoia Hospital begins

A New Era:

- 1996 Sequoia Hospital management is switched over to Catholic Healthcare West, now Dignity Health
- The Hospital District was renamed the Sequoia Healthcare District
- Present-SHD will remain vigilant in our mission to improve access to services, reduce health disparities and support the well well-being of all District residents through strong community collaborations, a new three-year strategic plan, and a focus on serving the most vulnerable members of our community.


